

## CAMP RANDALL

The Old Northwest Volunteers is having an event at Camp Randall in Madison on June 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup>. Bill Brewster and Jeff Kollath of the Wisconsin Veterans Museum brought this event together. Four different impressions will be presented to the public. These are listed below.

19<sup>th</sup> Wisconsin Vol Inf at Camp Randall in May of 1862. They will be guarding Confederates from Alabama taken prisoner at Island No. 10. (Equipment needed: forage cap, frock coat (preferred), pattern 1858 smoothside canteen with cotton or leather strap).

12<sup>th</sup> Wisconsin Vol Inf at Memphis in April of 1863. (Equipment needed: forage cap, frock coat (preferred), 1858 model smoothside canteen—Casey's Tactics used).

7<sup>th</sup> Wisconsin Vol Inf at Falmouth, Va in July 1862. (Equipment needed: Hardee hat with minimal ornamentation, sack coat, 1858 model canteen—drill manuals will be U.S. Infantry and Rifle Tactics and Baxter's Volunteer Manual).

Rations will be issued consisting of bacon, hardtack and coffee. Parking will be available at Lot 17 at the big ramp behind Camp Randall. It is a bit of a trek to the camp but there is no parking fee. Tom Klaas will be the captain in charge. Bill Brewster will give all registered participants a tour of the Veterans Museum on Saturday after 5 PM. Those interested must register online by May 29 and, in addition, sign a waiver form.
